Victim Dies in East Village Neighborhood Homicide

San Diego—On Monday, January 14, 2019, at 5:47 a.m., the San Diego Police Department Communications Center received a 911 call regarding a shooting at an apartment complex in the 900 block of Market Street. The caller stated there was a shooting in an apartment at the location.

Upon arriving at the location, officers were directed into the apartment and located a 30-year old black male with a gunshot wound to the upper body.

Officers administered medical aid on the victim until relieved by Paramedics. The victim was transported to a local hospital for treatment. His injuries were life threatening at that time.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident.

The victim was identified as 30-year –old Bradley Reynolds. Mr. Reynolds succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased on this morning, January 16, 2019.
