North Clairemont Neighborhood Homicide Victim Identified

San Diego—On Wednesday, January 3, 2018, at 7:00 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communication Center received a 911 call regarding a shooting on the 4600 block of Sauk Avenue.

The first police units to arrive found a Hispanic Male lying on the ground in front of his residence with an apparent gunshot wound to his head. The officers provided medical aid and the victim was transported to a local hospital by paramedics. The victim was not expected to survive his injuries.

The victim, who has been identified as 52 year old Frank Magana of San Diego, died from those injuries on Tuesday, January 16, 2018. Magana remained in the hospital until the time of his death.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives are continuing their investigation into Magana's murder. There is no suspect information that can be released at this time.
