**San Diego Police Investigate Homicide in the Teralta West Neighborhood**

San Diego—On Monday, March 4, 2019, at 8:55 a.m., the San Diego Police Department Communication Center received a 911 call regarding an injured female in an apartment in the 4000 block of Van Dyke Avenue.

San Diego Police Officers and San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel responded and arrived a few minutes later. They located a 36-year black female in the apartment with Traumatic injuries to her upper body. The female was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Homicide investigators were called to the scene and are investigating the death as a homicide. The initial investigation has revealed that family members last heard from the victim on Saturday. The victim's sister went to the location this morning at about 8:55 a.m., to check on the victim and discovered her body.

San Diego Police Department Homicide Detectives determined that 45-year old Abdiaziz Kerow murdered the victim and then fled the area before police arrived. A warrant has been issued for Kerow's arrest for murder. The victim has been identified as Muna Salad.
