**San Diego Police Investigate In Custody Death in Paradise Hills**

San Diego—On Monday, April 16, 2018, at 10:23 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communications Division received a 9-1-1 call from a resident in the 6300 block of Clyde Avenue. The caller requested paramedics and stated a relative was becoming violent and had possibly used narcotics. San Diego Police Officers and San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel responded to the scene and found a family member attempting to restrain the subject. The officers placed the subject in hand cuffs to prevent him from injuring himself or others so he could be medically evaluated. During the evaluation, the subject went into cardiac arrest and immediate lifesaving measures were initiated. The subject was transported to a local hospital where he was placed on life-support. The subject unfortunately succumbed to his medical condition on April 19, 2018.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident as a possible in custody death.

The subject has been identified as 39 year-old Guillermo Corrales.
