San Diego Police Make Arrest For Homicide In The Colina Del Sol Neighborhood

San Diego-On Saturday, December 22, 2018, at 5:58 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communication Center received a 911 call regarding a shooting at 5200 El Cajon Boulevard. The first police units to arrive found a 31-year old Black male and a 38-year old Black male lying on the ground. Both men sustained gunshot wound(s) to their upper body. Officers provided immediate medical aid to both victims, until relieved by paramedics. Both men were transported to local hospitals. Unfortunately, the 31-year old victim was pronounced deceased at the Hospital.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene to investigate the incident. The preliminary investigation showed that the victims were involved in an altercation with another group of males. At some point shots were fired and the victims were struck. The suspects were black males wearing dark clothing.

The 31-year old deceased victim was identified as Dionte Floyd.

Based on information developed during the investigation, 20-year old Mason Williams was identified as a suspect. Williams was arrested on January 30th and was booked into jail for the murder.

Investigators also identified 19- year old Kaelon Daniels as a suspect. Daniels was arrested in the Lakeside area of San Diego County on April 25th and booked into county jail for murder.
