San Diego Police Investigate Homicide in Miramar Ranch North Neighborhood

San Diego-On Sunday, April 29 2018, at 8:39 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communication Center received a 911 call regarding a shooting at the condominium complex located at 11215 Affinity Ct. The first police units to arrive found a 46-year old Vietnamese male lying on a bedroom floor. He was suffering from gunshot wound(s) to his upper body. Officers provided immediate medical aid to the victim, until relived by paramedics. Unfortunately, the victim was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Officers checked the condominium and surrounding area for the suspect, who is the victim's 15 year old son, but did not locate him.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. The preliminary investigation has shown that the victim and suspect live together and the shooting occurred inside of the condominium. At this time, detectives do not know what led to the shooting.

On Monday, at about 1:00 a.m., San Diego Police Department Communication Center received a call from a citizen stating they saw a subject who matched the suspect's description at 10100 Scripps Poway Parkway. Officers responded to the location and took the suspect into Custody.

The victim and suspect have been identified, but their identities will not be released pending family notification.

At this point in the investigation, we have no evidence that indicate additional shootings were planned.
