Victim Identified In Ocean Beach Homicide

San Diego- On May 1, 2019, at approximately 12:53 a.m., the San Diego Police Department received a call to check the welfare of a woman in the area of 5000 Niagara Avenue. The caller said a family member had received a message from his mother, which caused them to be concerned. They attempted to call her back, but could not reach her. The family believed she was checking on a property in the Ocean Beach neighborhood. Officers arrived in the area a few minutes later and began checking, with the assistance of the son who had called. They were unable to access to residence at that time and began checking the surrounding area. During that time, the son that had called the police returned to the property and saw his brother run off. The son that had called the police forced entry into the garage area at that time, finding a deceased person inside.

San Diego Police Homicide Investigators were called to the scene and are handling the investigation. The investigators are still in the process of interviewing relatives and witnesses to determine what happened, as well as serving search warrants to gather evidence.

The victim has been identified as 59 year-old Heidi Green, of Los Angeles County.

The suspect, 36 year-old Daniel Chase McKibben, was taken into custody after an officer-involved shooting incident in the City of La Mesa on May 2, 2019. He remains in custody at a local hospital. McKibben is the son of the victim, and lived in the Ocean Beach area.
