San Diego Police Investigate Homicide in Mountain View Neighborhood

San Diego—On Sunday, May 6, 2018, at 1:20 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communication Center received a 911 call regarding a shooting at 500 South 40th Street. The first police units to arrive found a 33-year old Black male and a 37-year old Black male lying on the ground. Both males were suffering from gunshot wound(s) to their upper body. Officers provided immediate medical aid to both victims, until relieved by paramedics. Both males were transported to Mercy hospital. Unfortunately, both victims were pronounced deceased at the Hospital.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. The preliminary investigation has shown that the victims were standing in front of the Rec Center at 500 S. 40th Street when a black male, wearing dark clothing walked up and began shooting.

Both victims have been identified as 33-year old Tony Jackson and 37-year old Robert Brown.

During their investigation, San Diego Police Homicide Detectives identified 29 year-old Shannon Bryant of San Diego as the suspect. Bryant has been charged with both Jackson's and Brown's murder and will be arraigned next week.
