San Diego Police Make Second Arrest In Double Homicide That Occurred In Mountain View Neighborhood

San Diego—On Sunday, May 6, 2018, at 1:20 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communication's Center received a 911 call of a shooting at 500 South 40th Street. The first police units to arrive found a 33 year-old Tony Jackson and a 37 year-old Robert Brown had sustained gunshot wound(s). Both were transported to a local hospital and later pronounced deceased.

On May 11, 2018, 29-year old Shannon Bryant of San Diego was identified as a suspect and arrested for his involvement with the murders. Bryant was arraigned today.

28 year-old Elliot Williams was also identified as a suspect in this case. Williams was in-custody on another matter and charged today for his involvement in the homicides. He is due to be arraigned on Thursday, May 17, 2018, at 1:30 p.m. in San Diego Superior Court.
