Arrests Made In College Area Homicide

San Diego—On Thursday, May 02, 2019, at 6:17 a.m., the San Diego Police Department's Communication Center received a 911 call regarding a shooting on the 6300 block of Alvarado Road. San Diego Police Officers arrived approximately seven minutes later and located a black adult man with a gunshot wound to his upper body. Medics also responded and performed life saving measures. The man was transported to a local hospital, where unfortunately he was pronounced deceased.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene to investigate the incident. Although the investigation is still ongoing, we have learned the victim had contact with at least two suspects on the 6300 block of Alvarado Road. At some point during the interaction gunshots were fired. The suspects fled the scene on foot, leaving the victim at the scene.

The victim was been identified as 39-year old Ishi Hampton.

As a result of information developed during the investigation, two juveniles – ages 14 and 15 – were taken into custody and placed into Juvenile Hall for their involvement in the homicide. The names of the juveniles will not be released due to their age. The investigation continues, and additional arrests may be forthcoming. This case has been issued by the San Diego County District Attorney's Office, additional inquiries should be directed to their Media Relations Department.
