Police Identify Victim And Suspects In Paradise Hills Homicide

San Diego- On June 29, 2019, at approximately 12:58 a.m., the San Diego Police Department Communications Center received a 911 call regarding a shooting in the 6200 block of Childs Avenue. Patrol officers arrived on scene a few minutes later and found a 20 year-old male down in the driveway of a residence, with a family member performing CPR. The officers immediately assisted with the life-saving efforts until they were relieved by San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel. Unfortunately, the victim did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased at 1:07 a.m. The victim had suffered at least one apparent gunshot wound. As the patrol officers were securing the scene, they were contacted by residents in the area who had heard what they believed were gunshots and noticed some suspicious activity. Based on the information provided by the residents, three people were detained for questioning (an adult male and female, and a male juvenile).

Investigators from the Homicide Unit were called to the scene to conduct the investigation. As a result of the investigation, two of the three people detained by the patrol officers have been arrested for their part in the homicide. 19 year-old Angelo Roshon Richardson Jr was booked into San Diego County Jail for murder and being a felon in possession of a firearm. 18 year-old Mikayla Ann Castillo was book into Las Colinas Women's Detention Center for being an accessory to murder and carrying a concealed weapon, but has since been released on bail. The 17 year-old male was released pending further investigation.

Although the loss of any life is a tragedy, this case is a good illustration of the partnership between the community and law enforcement. The cooperation of the community members will greatly assist in determining what occurred, and helping to provide closure for the victim's family.

The victim has been identified as 20 year-old Tyshawn Powell.
