San Diego Police make arrest in Teralta West Homicide

On Friday, December 15, 2017, at 7:25 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communications Center received a call reporting multiple gunshots in the area of 4100 Central Avenue.

Officers found two males at that location who were struck by gunfire. Despite life-saving efforts, 31 year-old Kenneth Williams of San Diego was pronounced deceased at the scene. A second victim was transported to a local hospital and treated.

As a result of the investigation, 28 year-old Andrew Brown of San Diego was identified as the suspect in this case.

Brown was arrested on July 10, 2018, in the 3900 block of University Avenue and was booked into the San Diego County Jail for murder and attempted murder. He is due to be arraigned in San Diego Superior Court on Thursday, July 12, 2018, at 1:30 p.m.
