Arrest Made in Fairmont Village Homicide

San Diego—On Saturday, June 16, 2018, at 5:11 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communication's Center received a 911 call from a resident in the 3600 block of 45th Street regarding a possible death. The first patrol officers arrived and discovered a 21 year-old female deceased in an apartment. The female had suffered apparent traumatic injuries.

Homicide investigators were called to the scene and determined the death was a homicide. The initial investigation has revealed the victim returned home on June 16, 2018, at approximately 5:45 a.m., after going out with friends. Her body was discovered by family members just after 5:00 p.m. that night.

The victim was subsequently identified as 21 year old Jossie Marilyn Ruiz Lopez, of San Diego.

The investigation led to 26 year-old Dominique Grady being identified as the suspect in this case. The San Diego County District Attorney's Office filed murder charges against Grady and a warrant for his arrest was issued. On July 23, 2018, Grady was located and arrested in Las Vegas, Nevada with the help of the Las Vegas Fugitive Investigative Strike Team. Grady is being held pending extradition for the murder of Ruiz.
