Police Investigate Suspicious Death in Barrio Logan

San Diego—On Thursday, July 26, 2018, at 2:06 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communication Center received a 911 call regarding a check the welfare request from a resident in the 2900 block of Boston Avenue. The caller stated there was a foul smell coming from a parked vehicle and there appeared to be blood outside of the vehicle.

San Diego Police Officers and San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel responded and arrived a few minutes later. The responding officers were directed to a 2006 Chevrolet HHR. They were able to gain entry into the vehicle and discovered the body of a deceased adult male inside.

The initial investigation could not explain the exact circumstances surrounding the male's death. Out of an abundance of caution, the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit was called to the scene.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives are continuing to investigate this incident as a suspicious death. The victim has been identified as 61 year-old Ruben Enrique Aranda, of National City, California.
