Search Warrant Served For Illegal Marijuana Delivery Service

San Diego–June 26, 2018, at approximately 1200 hours, the San Diego Police Department’s Narcotics Unit served a search warrant at 2056 1st Avenue. This location was being used to operate an illegal marijuana delivery service called “GC Petals.” Upon service of the search warrant it was discovered that “GC Petals” was also operating as an illegal walk-in dispensary.

The search warrant yielded approximately 24 lbs. of high grade marijuana, concentrated cannabis and edibles, \$3100 in cash, and business documents and records. One employee was present and was arrested for operating a business without a license and sales of marijuana.

Enforcement and Prosecution of all Illegal Marijuana Businesses in San Diego

As was evident by yesterday’s operation, SDPD and the City Attorney’s office are continuing to conduct enforcement on all illegal marijuana delivery services, as well as, all other illegal marijuana businesses operating in the City of San Diego. All persons operating these illegal marijuana businesses will be arrested and prosecuted.
