**San Diego Police Investigating Possible Homicide in Fairmont Village**

San Diego—On Saturday, June 16, 2018, at 5:11 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communication's Center received a 911 call from a resident in the 3600 block of 45<sup>th</sup> Street regarding a possible death. The first patrol officers arrived and discovered a 21 year-old female deceased in an apartment. The female had suffered apparent traumatic injuries.

Homicide investigators were called to the scene and are investigating the death as a possible homicide. The initial investigation has revealed the victim returned home on June 16, 2018, at approximately 5:45 a.m., after going out with friends. Her body was discovered by family members just after 5:00 p.m. that night. No suspects have been identified at this time.
