Council President Gómez Calls for Investigation into 'Unacceptable' Police Conduct

Detectives Take Woman Away in Unmarked Vehicle, Threaten to Shoot Protesters

SAN DIEGO – City Council President Georgette Gómez today issued the following statement about an <u>incident</u> that occurred Thursday evening, when plainclothes San Diego Police detectives pulled a woman into an unmarked vehicle and threatened to shoot protesters asking who they were and what they were doing:

"I am calling for an immediate and thorough investigation into this incident, and for the officer who threatened to kill unarmed protesters to be placed on leave. It is incredibly disturbing to hear police officers threaten people's lives."
