


AREA MAP:




CONCEPT STATEMENT :

Civita Park is a 14.3 acre park with over 165 feet of grade change that provides numerous amenities for the Mission Valley community. The southern edge of the park is anchored by a large civic plaza which incudes an interactive water feature, stage and turf amphitheatre, life size chess, social gathering nodes and multiple seating opportunities. A formal promenade surrounded by urban gardens line the eastern edge of the park. Civita Creek, providing water quality and aesthetic benefits, frames the western edge of the park. Numerous opportunities for recreation include large passive turf areas, children's play areas, half basketball courts, interpretive gardens and a community garden. A plaza space with a comfort station, located in the center of the park, is filled with mining relics that reference the history of the site. The park offers dramatic views of Mission Valley from the upper gardens and gathering spaces. Security and accent lighting will be integrated throughout the park. The proposed drought tolerant plant palette responds to the surrounding community by providing a gardenesque blend of colors and textures.
