

PROTEST.

Whereas, a petition has been filed with the City Council asking for a license to conduct a saloon at 1419 D St., bet. 5th & 6th streets, therefore be it:

Resolved, that we the members of the *First Baptist* church, in midweek meeting assembled, earnestly protest against said proposed saloon and urge that the application for a license therefor be denied:

First, because any saloon does harm.

Second, because the proposed site is at the junction of all street cars of the city where great numbers of children and youths must necessarily congregate while waiting for cars.

Third, because a saloon in that special place, being on the great thoroughfare of the city, will be an eyesore to San Diegans and tourists alike, give the latter a bad impression and so result in positive damage to the city, even from a financial standpoint.

The above preamble ~~was moved~~ and resolution was unanimously carried at a meeting of the *First Baptist* church held this 21 day of Dec. 1904.
