Subject: Webinars on Online Permitting Enhancements for Residential Solar Photovoltaic

Next week, the Development Services Department (DSD) will host a webinar to help customers apply for residential solar photovoltaic permits and battery storage projects. The online seminar will explain planned upgrades to online permitting per Senate Bill 379 and include a live demonstration on applying for a permit.

These upgrades will make applying for a solar PV permit and battery-storage projects up to 38.4 kilowatts for single-dwelling units and duplexes faster and easier. With the planned changes scheduled to be rolled out next month, customers will be able to submit new residential solar PV and battery storage applications, upload plans and specifications, and receive a permit in real time through DSD's online permitting portal.
