WHEREAS, the Council now seeks to adopt a Compensation Philosophy that will be reviewed and updated periodically to be consistent with the City's strategic objectives; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council adopts the Compensation Philosophy on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR-313871
