A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING AND APPROVING THE TENTATIVE AGREEMENT AND APPROVING THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY AND THE SAN DIEGO POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION REGARDING TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT FOR FISCAL YEARS 2023 AND 2024.

WHEREAS, by San Diego Resolution R-313633 (July 12, 2021), the San Diego City Council (Council) approved a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of San Diego (City) and the San Diego Police Officers Association (POA) regarding terms and conditions of employment for employees represented by POA for Fiscal Year 2022; and

WHEREAS, Article 5 of the MOU provides a reopener to negotiate proposals for a successor MOU, in accordance with the Meyers-Milias-Brown Act (MMBA), California's collective bargaining law binding on the City, and Council Policy 300-06, the City's employee-employer relations policy; and

WHEREAS, from November 2021 to June 2022, the City's Management Team for labor relations and representatives of POA met and conferred in accordance with the reopener provision and reached a tentative agreement, referred to as the Total Package Tentative Agreement (TPTA), setting forth the terms and conditions of employment for a two-year MOU, covering Fiscal Years 2023 and 2024, and POA members have ratified the TPTA; and

WHEREAS, the MMBA, and more specifically California Government Code section 3505.1, provides: "If a tentative agreement is reached by the authorized representatives of the public agency and a recognized employee organization or recognized employee organizations, the governing body shall vote to accept or reject the tentative agreement within

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30 days of the date it is first considered at a duly noticed public meeting. A decision by the governing body to reject the tentative agreement shall not bar the filing of a charge of unfair practice for failure to meet and confer in good faith. If the governing body adopts the tentative agreement, the parties shall jointly prepare a written memorandum of understanding"; and

WHEREAS, under the San Diego City Charter (Charter), the MMBA, and Council Policy 300-06, it is within the discretion of the Council to approve the TPTA and the MOU; and

WHEREAS, the City's Management Team has prepared and presented the TPTA and the MOU to the Council for final determination, and the Council wishes to approve them; and

WHEREAS, the TPTA and the MOU must be approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the Council, in accordance with Charter section 11.2; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, under the authority of the Charter, the MMBA, and Council Policy 300-06, the Council accepts and approves the TPTA between the City and POA for Fiscal Years 2023 and 2024, on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document NEW 314185:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, under the authority of the Charter, the MMBA, and Council Policy 300-06, the Council approves the MOU between the City and POA for Fiscal Years 2023 and 2024, on file with the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. 314185.2 APPROVED: MARA W. ELLIOTT, City Attorney
