RAINWATER DIVERSION SYSTEM TEST CERTIFICATION

Applicability: These instructions apply to any industry whose Industrial User Discharge Permit Attachment B, Self Monitoring and Reporting Requirements, includes "Certify rainwater diversion system tested". To report compliance with this requirement, the following statement must be submitted, signed as required in the permit under <u>STANDARD CONDITIONS</u>, <u>Signatory Requirements</u>. Rainwater Diversion System Test Certification is required of industrial users that have installed rainwater diversion systems to prevent discharge of excessive rainwater to sewer during rain events.

Rainwater Diversion System Test Certification: The following statement must be certified and signed by an authorized representative of the industry and submitted with each Industrial Self-Monitoring report:

"Based on my management of operations at the permitted facility, or my inquiry of the persons so managing, I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, all components of the rainwater diversion system (RDS) were tested between August 1st and September 30th of this year, as required by the current permit. If the RDS passed, I certify all components operational; system will divert stormwater from sewer as required by permit. If the test failed, I certify the RDS will be returned to working order within 30 days of the failure date. I further certify that I understand the system must be functional at all times throughout the year. I am aware of the potential for significant penalties for submission of false information, including the possibility of fines and imprisonment for knowing violations."
