RB Planning Board – SANDAG Update (Steve Dow)

- **May 2022 Newsletter highlights**
  - Bike Trails:
    - Landis Bikeway opening (North Park / City Heights)
    - Opened 11 miles new bikeway in 2021
    - Expects to start construction of 11 more miles by end of 2022
  - Free Transit for Youth Pilot Program
    - Anyone under 18 can ride bus, Trolley, COASTER, and SPRINTER for free until June 2023.
  - Fast Tracks Transit to Airport
    - Central Mobility Hub now expected to be downtown
    - Two direct transit centers expected at Pot HQ on Pacific Highway and the existing Sante Fe Depot. These two will eventually connect to a future Central Mobility Hub downtown (location TBD).
    - The Naval Information Warfare Systems Command (NAVWAR) location will no longer be explored as the main central hub location.
  - SANDAG hauled 26 Olympic-sized pools of sand to Moonlight and Cardiff State Beach
  - SANDAG celebrates Asian American & Pacific Islander month
