Sherman Calls on California Public Utilities Commission to Deny Quail Brush Power Plant

SAN DIEGO – Councilmember Scott Sherman today spoke before the California Public Utilities Commission (PUC) urging them to deny the construction of the Quail Brush Power Plant. Sherman's comments came during a heated meeting where dozens of community members rallied against the power plant.

“As the local representative for Mission Trails Park, this issue hits close to home. I am opposed to the construction of this power plant in the middle of an unspoiled regional park,” Sherman stated.

The proposed site for the power plant is located in Councilmember Sherman's District and is in the middle of designated open space lands and adjacent to Mission Trails Regional Park - one of the largest urban parks in the United States.

One of Sherman's first actions as a City Councilmember was to send a letter to the PUC in December urging them to reject this power plant.

Sherman represents the eastern part of the City of San Diego on the City Council, including Mission Trails Park where the power plant would be constructed.
