Hunger2Help "Burrito Boyz" to be Honored by Councilmember Sherman

Team of high school students from Tierrasanta has served over 29,000 burritos to city's homeless community

Why:	The Hunger2Help team, dubbed "The Burrito Boyz," are high school students from Tierrasanta and recently celebrated their second full year of service to San Diego's homeless community. Every Sunday morning, the Burrito Boyz are up at dawn to prepare 350 hot meals. They pack-up, head out, navigate the streets of downtown and distribute breakfast burritos, water, paperback novels, clothing, and other toiletries to the city's homeless population. <u>Hunger2Help has served over 29,000 burritos since its inception.</u> Their service has been recognized by the San Diego Chargers, LA Lakers, and most recently they were honored with the National George Washington Medal of Honor Award from the Freedom Foundation at Valley Forge. The U-T San Diego and CBS Evening News have also carried stories featuring their accomplishments.
