COUNCILMEMBER COLE APPOINTED TO KEY CITY COUNCIL COMMITTEES

SAN DIEGO, Calif. – San Diego City Councilmember Myrtle Cole was selected by her colleagues today to serve on three key Council Committees. She was unanimously appointed to the Infrastructure, Land Use and Housing, and Public Safety and Neighborhood Services committees.

“I am honored by the confidence my colleagues have in my ability to serve on these vital committees,” said Councilmember Cole. “Public safety and improved infrastructure are among my top priorities and I look forward to working with my fellow committee members to improve and better serve our neighborhoods.”

Councilmember Cole emphasized the need to address cracked sidewalks, pot-hole filled roads, broken storm drains and neglected city facilities throughout the city and especially in the southeastern San Diego communities that comprise her 4th Council District.

“This is the time and I am the Councilmember who make sure that our most needy neighborhoods get the police and fire services as well as the new and improved sidewalks and streets that they deserve,” said Councilmember Cole.

In addition, she was appointed as an alternative on the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) Board of Directors and named a City representative on the San Diego City-County Reinvestment Task Force.
