A Clear View of San Diego: Ceremonial Pole Removal Lincoln Park Community Utilities Undergrounding Project

SAN DIEGO, **CA** --- Councilmember Myrtle Cole will be joined by representatives from San Diego Gas & Electric, Cox Communications, AT&T, staff from the Transportation & Storm Water Department, and community members for the ceremonial pole removal that punctuates the end of the project that placed overhead utilities underground. This is the first undergrounding project to be completed in the Fourth Council District.

Why: Lincoln Park Project Block Highlights:

3.5 miles of utilities undergrounded

- More than 400 private residences utilities undergrounded
- 62 Streetlights and 22 curb ramps were installed
- 132 shade trees were planted
- Streets will be resurfaced or slurry sealed curb-to-curb by Spring 2014

Residents and visitors to the area will benefit from the increased street lighting, new curb ramps, and a clear view of San Diego in Lincoln Park.
