Sherman Unveils Navajo Parks Renovation Plan

SAN DIEGO – Today Councilmember Scott Sherman unveiled the Navajo Parks Renovation Plan (NRPR), an effort to renovate neighborhood assets. Sherman was joined by community stakeholders and city staff at the San Carlos Recreation Center to make this announcement.

For the NPRP \$50,419 has been dedicated from the District 7 Community Projects, Programs and Services fund to renovate six District 7 neighborhood parks, which include: Allied Gardens Community Park, Lake Murray Community Park, Lower Lewis Joint Use Field, Princess Del Cerro Neighborhood Park, San Carlos Recreation Center Joint Use Field, and Skunk Hollow. City staff will be performing the work for this project.

Sherman became concerned after hearing from residents that there have been increased injuries, possibly due to the deteriorating condition of the parks. “It was time to act since the City has been unable to adequately maintain these parks due to budget constraints,” said Councilmember Sherman.

The renovation process includes aerating, reseeding and fertilizing each park. The parks will be fenced off and closed for about eight weeks during this process. A breakdown of the anticipated schedule is below:

Lake Murray Park	January (last week)	February - March 30th
Princess Del Cerro	February (last week)	February - April 1st
Skunk Hollow	April	April - May
Allied Gardens Community Park (Peanut)	May (1st week)	May - June
Lower Lewis	May	May - June
San Carlos Recreation Center	July	July - August

Sherman also acknowledged Jay Wilson, President of the Del Cerro Action Council, and Terry Cords, President of the Allied Gardens Recreation Council, for their assistance in coordinating the renovation schedule with the sports leagues who utilize the fields.
