

**BOARD OF EDUCATION

IN THE MATTER OF SUPPORT FOR ADOPTION)
AND IMPLEMENTATION OF COMMUNITY CHOICE) **RESOLUTION**
AGGREGATION IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO)

WHEREAS, at the July 14, 2015 meeting, the Board of Education of the San Diego Unified School District supported the development of a San Diego Unified Climate Action Plan (CAP) in alignment with the overall goals of the City of San Diego CAP to achieve 100 percent renewable energy by 2035, and to provide local control and build-out of citywide clean energy programs; and

WHEREAS, the results of the Feasibility Study of Community Choice Aggregation (CCA) determined that CCA is feasible for San Diego and will allow local and publicly accountable control of energy decisions; and

WHEREAS, electricity rates have increased 61 percent since 2009 and continue to rise, adding significant costs to San Diego Unified's budget which inhibits our ability to spend funds on other critical projects; and

WHEREAS, CCA is structured as a nonprofit entity whose primary responsibility is to serve the public interest and, according to the technical study, will be able to stabilize rates and offer competitive or reduced costs; and

WHEREAS, the technical study validates that CCA will enable the City of San Diego to reach its goal of 100 percent renewable energy; and

WHEREAS, CCA can source an increasing share of power from local, clean sources, supporting local jobs and local economic development reducing greenhouse gas emissions, and providing cleaner air; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Unified continues to work on solar energy installations, and recognizes that CCA will generate revenue that can be reinvested into the community for rooftop solar energy and other innovative energy programs; and

WHEREAS, CCA can promote social equity by collaborating with community organizations to prioritize reinvestment of revenue in local clean energy resources and programs that serve disadvantaged communities; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Unified Climate Mitigation Adaptation Plan includes adopting CCA as a strategy to access 100 percent of our electric power requirements from renewable sources by 2035; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Unified could consider advocating locally for reasonable rates by requesting a seat on the CCA governing board to represent the interests of San Diego Unified.




