

Linda Vista Planning Group (LVPG)

The Linda Vista Planning Group is officially recognized by the City of San Diego to advise and make recommendations to the City Council, the Planning Commission, City staff, and other governmental agencies on land use matters relating to the greater Linda Vista community.

The Linda Vista Planning Group created an ad hoc subcommittee on the development of the Riverwalk Golf Course that is in Mission Valley and borders Linda Vista. This ad hoc subcommittee is tasked to work with the Mission Valley Planning Group and the developer on issues of mutual community interest such as traffic, parking, pedestrian access and safety, and other relevant planning matters, and to make regular reports to the LVPG.

<u>Please note</u>: Due to the COVID-19 public health emergency, the Linda Vista Riverwalk Ad Hoc Subcommittee is currently unable to host a physical meeting. Instead, pursuant to the Governor's executive order N-25-20, as interpreted by City authorities, the Subcommittee's April meeting will be held via video/teleconference.

The Linda Vista Riverwalk Ad Hoc Subcommittee will meet via video/teleconference on Monday, April 27, 2020 at 6:00 p.m.

Hines (the developer) will host a discussion on the Zoom electronic platform concerning:

- 1. the Riverwalk Specific Plan; and
- 2. the Riverwalk Project Environmental Impact Report (EIR).

Questions by the Subcommittee relating to parking, traffic, public park land, flooding, and roadway improvements have been submitted in advance to Hines.
