SDPZ Draft Indicators Generated During June and July 2017 Working Group Meetings

Overview: The San Diego Promise Zone (SDPZ) July working group meetings identified a list of indicators and potential data sources to measure the progress of the SDPZ in the next 10 years. The development of these indicators will occur in phases.

- <u>Phase 1:</u> Indicators SDPS will track within the next four months.
- <u>Phase 2:</u> Indicators that require integration of multiple data sources. Projected to be tracked within 6 to 9 months.
 <u>Phase 3:</u> Indicators that capture the work of more than one working group and which require further definition and
- integration of data sources. Timeline for tracking these indicators is not yet determined.
- <u>Phase 4:</u> Indicators which require further definition and identification of data sources before they are considered for development.
