REGISTRATION

- * Registration is taken on a first come, first serve, basis, online or in person. Phone or mail registration is not accepted.
- * When classes fill to capacity, waiting lists are formed. Classes *may* be expanded to accomodate additional students.
- * If classes do not meet minimum enrollment, they will be cancelled and a refund will be issued.

PAYMENT METHOD

- Payment is required at the time of registration.
- Payment methods taken at the Center are credit card or electronic check.
- Online class registration from home requires credit card payment.
- Credit cards accepted are VISA, MasterCard, American Express and Discover.
- A fee will be charged for all returned checks.
- Financial assistance is available. Please submit the application to the Recreation Center office one week prior to the start of registration.
- Class fees are not prorated/discounted after the beginning of the scheduled session.

REFUND POLICY

Written refund applications must be submitted, using the Application for Miscellaneous Refund Form (COM-6), in person at the facility where the program occurs. Refunds will be processed in accordance with the following policy:

- Activity fees less than \$10.00 will not be refunded Classes:

Refund is based on the date that the written application is submitted.

- 96.5% refund 3 or more calendar days prior to the first day of the class
- 75% refund less than 3 calendar days prior to the first day of class
- No refund for requests submitted more than 24 hours after the first day of class

<u>Camps:</u> Refund is based on the date that the written application is submitted.

- 96.5% refund 10 or more calendar days prior to the first day of camp
- 50% refund less than 10 calendar days prior to the first day of camp

RECREATION CENTER & PARK INFORMATION

WEIGHT ROOM USAGE

A gym daily pass or Membership is required for use of the weight room. Times are subject to change without prior notification. **Drinks**, and food are prohibited from the weight room Patrons must have a towel and must wear closed toe shoes. NO EXCEPTIONS!

BASKETBALL

There are 2 half basketball courts behind the recreation center. All ages are welcome. Lights are turned on at dusk & shut off by 10PM. It is available on a first come, first serve basis.

TENNIS COURT

The tennis court is open and available to the public all ages welcomed. It is located in the back of the recreation center on a first come first serve basis.

No organized play, practice or instruction is allowed on the courts without an approved permit.

FIELD USAGE

The Barnard and Crown Point Elementary Joint-Use Fields are a partnership between the City of San Diego and the San Diego Unified School District. The playing fields are closed to public for use 1/2 hour before the start of the school day bell and up until 1/2 hour after the end of the school day bell. RECYCLE

AED

For patrons in cardiac arrest, an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) is located inside the Santa Clara Recreation Center lobby.

CONTRACTUAL PROGRAM OR, RENTAL PROGRAM

Santa Clara Recreation Center is now offering a variety of programs for youth & adults. Contractual programs consist of independent contractors that have been approved through Parks & Recreation. Rental programs are commercial companies that rent out the facility to offer privately run programs and activities for the community. Please see below for specified requirements:

Requirements for Independent Contractors:

All contractors, sub-contractors and volunteers must be finger-printed through the City of San Diego Live Scan Process.

Contractors must submit a business license and proof of insurance. City staff handles all registration for the program Contractors must provide Worker's compensation coverage for all their employees.

Requirements for Permit Holders/Rental Programs

Must provide proof of insurance. Must provide own advertisement for program.

Handles all registration for their programs. Rental programs are NOT required to submit proof of fingerprinting for their coaches, volunteers and/or instructors.

Distributing registration and program information is the responsibility of each individual businesses. Please contact them directly for all program inquires.
