COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS REPORTS:

Consuelo Delgadillo of Hearts & Hands Working Together informed everyone that they have food distributions on the first Tuesday of the month at Mt. Carmel and on the third Friday of the month at the Las Americas Premium Outlets. Hearts & Hands meetings take place on the fourth Friday of every month at the San Ysidro Public Library, 101 West San Ysidro Blvd. The public is welcome to attend.

Juan Lopez of 'A.I.C.I.' informed everyone that the group held a Fiestas Patrias event at the San Ysidro Senior Center on September 15 from 5:00 to 9:45 p.m. The event was well, and a lot of people attended.

PARKS & RECREATION STAFF REPORT:

Area Manager Francisco Castruita reported the following:

- Thanked SYCAC staff for their professionalism and assistance with San Diego Police, La Mirada Elementary School and District Faculty regarding the incident that occurred in a home across the street from the school.
- The City arborist inspected and evaluated a Eucalyptus tree at Howard Lane Neighborhood Park a resident requested to be removed next to their home. The tree was determined to be healthy with no sign of disease and does not encroach on the resident's property.
- New security lights will be installed near Vista Terrace Pool/Vista Terrace Neighborhood Park. It will be LED lighting which will help with needed security in the parking lot. Installation will begin next month.

Pool Manager Hector Sanchez of Vista Terrace Pool reported the following:

- Introduced himself as the new Pool Manager and is looking forward to working with everyone and the community.
- Vista Terrace Pool's Unfunded Park Improvement's are currently underway. Painting and plastering of the facility are happening this week.
- City has approved to install new shading and security fencing in January 2023.
- Pool activity use schedule remains the same. Currently, Montgomery High School is using for water polo.
- Staff will request to expand additional hours of operation of pool use for everyone.

Recreation Center Director Mari Jo Ricanor reported the following for Cesar Chavez Community Center:

- Free dinner meals to youth up to 18 years old are being offered until summer 2023, unless there is a drop in attendance. These meals are served at from 5:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
- Staff took 10 kids to a Padre game on September 21, sponsored by the San Diego Parks Foundation.

- Staff is currently coaching youth for the upcoming flag football season. They are actively recruiting for pee wee, 10u, and 12u division teams. Practices will take place at Larsen Field and games will be held at Silverwing and South Bay Recreation Centers.
- On September 22, staff took 25 teens to the annual Haunted Trails at Balboa Park.
- Staff will offer a free Halloween Carnival on October 27 inside the gym from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. Carnival games, cupcake walk, and costume contest will be offered.

Recreation Center Director Belinda Fimbres reported the following for San Ysidro Teen Center:

- Staff will host in October a Día de los Muertos activities from October 24 to October 28.
- Staff will offer pumpkin carving on October 26 at 3:30 p.m.

Recreation Center Director Robert Lara reported the following for San Ysidro Community Activity Center:

- The San Diego Humane Society held a 'Pup' Up event at La Mirada Elementary, Joint Use Field on October 1st from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Services for pets included pet supplies, microchipping and low-cost vaccines for dogs and cats. No appointment was necessary. The next event will take place on November 11.
- Staff will be taking registrations for the upcoming Toys for Tots Program next week. See staff in office for more information.
- Staff took 25 teens to the Haunted Trails at Balboa Park on September 22.
- Staff is still offering a flag football program to pee wee, 10u and 12u age divisions. Games will be held at Silverwing and South Bay Recreation Centers.
- San Ysidro Community Activity Center will host voting polls November 5 to November 8.
- Staff will hold weekly activities in October leading up to Halloween on October 31.
