- Six trenchless crossings and one bridge crossing
- Dechlorination facility
- Water main replacement, including installation of 34,000 linear feet of 12" and 16" PVC water mains
- One mile of 8" to 54" subaqueous HDPE pipe installed in Miramar Reservoir

SD What You Can **Expect – Pipeline Work**

- Nighttime construction from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
 - Access for residents, businesses and emergency vehicles will be maintained
 - Expect delays due to traffic control
- At minimum, one lane in both directions open at all times
- Scheduled water outages
- Construction equipment and material staging areas will move along the alignment as construction progresses
- 24/7 construction at the tunnel crossing at I-15
