INDIVDUALS WITH DISABILITIES

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Please Note: Businesses that rent facility space from the City of San Diego & the Scripps Ranch Recreation Center will be distributing their own registration and program information. Please contact them directly for REGISTRATION and program inquires.

REGISTRATION FOR IN-HOUSE CLASSES ARE ONLY AVAILABLE ONLINE OR IN OFFICE **STARTING FEBRUARY 10, 2024**

Children under 18 must be registered by their parent/legal guardian. Register early for best availability. When camps fill to capacity, waiting lists are formed. Many camps are expanded to accommodate additional students. However, to ensure program quality for all participants, no exceptions are made regarding class enrollment sizes. All participants must meet age requirements.

PAYMENT POLICY:

- Payment is required at the time of registration or online.
- Payment methods for registrations are a credit card or electronic check.
- Online Class registration requires a credit card payment.
- Credit cards accepted are VISA, MasterCard, Discover, or American Express. We cannot accept debit.
- A \$25 fee will be charged for all returned items from bank. (ie: non-sufficient funds, stop payment, incorrect account number, etc.)
- Camp/Class fees are not prorated/discounted after the beginning of the scheduled session.

Fill out the New Account request form completely, including all required fields (Birth date, gender, email address, etc.) and click submit. Please submit your request only once. You will receive a confirmation email at the email address that you provided. Please follow directions provided to active account.

*Please Note: (For first time users only) Parents/Guardian must create their own account first using their own information. Once you have an online registration account, you will have the opportunity to add a child as a family member.

Registration/Reservation Processing Fee

A 3.56% non-refundable processing fee will automatically be added to all charges.

CLASS REFUND POLICY EFFECTIVE January 1, 2023

This Policy applies to city and contractual classes. Refunds are based on the date that the written application is submitted.

- A 96.5% refund of the registration fees paid will be granted if the refund application is submitted at least 3 calendar days prior to the first class meeting.
- A 75% refund of the registration fees paid will be granted if the refund application is submitted less than 3 calendar days prior to the first class meeting.
- No Refund or Transfer will be granted for requests submitted later than 24 hours after the first class meeting.

If a class is cancelled by the City, a full refund of the activity fee will be issued except the city will retain the following.

- Any transaction and processing fees.
- Activity fees less than \$10.00
- No Refund or transfer for non-attendance at any class.
- No Credits on Account
- No refunds for costumes or equipment.

*Refund application must be completed online/email.





IN-HOUSE CAMP REFUND POLICY EFFECTIVE January 1, 2023

This Policy applies to In-House Camps (Contractual Camps) Refund application must be completed in person.

- A 96.5% refund of the registration fees paid will be granted if the refund application is submitted at least 10 calendar days prior to the first day of camp.
- A 50% refund of the registration fees paid will be granted if the refund application is submitted less than 10 calendar days prior to the first day of camp.
- No Refund or Transfer will be granted 48 hours or less from the start of camp.

If a In-House Camp is cancelled by the City, a full refund of the activity fee will be issued, but the city will retain the following:

- Any transaction and credit card fees.
- Activity fees less than \$10.00
- No Refund or transfer for non-attendance at any class.
- No Credits on Account
