REGISTRATION FOR IN-HOUSE CAMPS ONLY IS AVAILABLE ONLINE OR IN OFFICE STARTING SATURDAY, MARCH 7, 2020 AT 10:00 AM AND SUMMER CLASSES SATURDAY MAY 9, 2020 AT 10:00 AM

Children under 18 must be registered by their parent/legal guardian. Register early for best availability. When camps fill to capacity, waiting lists are formed. Many camps are expanded to accommodate additional students. However, to ensure program quality for all participants, no exceptions are made regarding class enrollment sizes. All participants must meet age requirements.

#### **PAYMENT POLICY:**



- Payment is required at the time of registration.
- Payment methods for registrations taken at the Center are a credit card or electronic check.
- Online Class registration requires a credit card payment.
- Credit cards accepted are VISA, MasterCard,, Discover, or American Express. We cannot accept debit.
- A \$25 fee will be charged for all returned items from bank.

- Camp/Class fees are not prorated/discounted after the beginning of the scheduled session.

#### Registration/Reservation Transaction & Credit Card

Effective February 17, 2018 processing fees will apply as follows for all transactions. All customers will be charged a \$2.00 transaction fee for all registrations and permits completed in person and at home. If paying with a credit card an additional 3% of the total transaction will also apply both in person and at home. Rates are established by the service provider and are nonrefundable.

#### **CLASS REFUND POLICY EFFECTIVE October 4, 2019**

This Policy applies to city and contractual classes. Refunds are based on the date that the written application is submitted.

- A 97% refund of the registration fees paid will be granted if the refund application is submitted at least 3 calendar days prior to the first class meeting.
- A 75% refund of the registration fees paid will be granted if the refund application is submitted less than 3 calendar days prior to the first class meeting.
- No Refund or Transfer will be granted for requests submitted later than 24 hours after the first class meeting.
   If an class is cancelled by the City, a full refund of the activity fee will be issued except the city will retain the following.
- Any transaction and processing fees.
- Activity fees less than \$10.00
- No Refund or transfer for non-attendance at any class.
- No Credits on Account
- No refunds for costumes or equipment.
- \*Refund application must be completed in person.



### IN-HOUSE CAMP REFUND POLICY EFFECTIVE October 4, 2019

This Policy applies to In-House Camps (Contractual Camps) Refund application must be completed in person.

- A 97% refund of the registration fees paid will be granted if the refund application is submitted at least 10 calendar days prior to the first day of camp.
- A 50% refund of the registration fees paid will be granted if the refund application is submitted less than 10 calendar days prior to the first day of camp.
