Hazardous Materials Spill/Release Reporting- In California, any significant release or threatened release of a hazardous material requires immediate reporting by the responsible person to the Cal OES State Warning Center (800) 852-7550 and the [Unified Program Agency \(UPA\)](#) County of San Diego, Hazardous Materials Division (858) 505- 6657 or 911. Federal Law- Notification to the National Response Center (NRC) 1-800-424-8802 is required for releases that is equal or exceed Federal Reporting Quantities (RQ) under EPCRA, and CERCLA.

Paints- PaintCare sites accept house paint and primers, stains, sealers, and clear coatings (e.g., shellac and varnish), but do not accept aerosols (spray cans), solvents, and products intended for industrial or non-architectural use. Paints must be in containers that are no larger than 5 gallons in size. Paint must be in its original container and the container must have a label and a secured lid. No open or leaking cans. Trauma Scene Practitioners- A trauma scene waste management practitioner is a person who undertakes as a commercial activity the removal of human blood, human body fluids, and other associated residues from the scene of a serious human injury, illness, or death. A practitioner shall register with the California Department of Public Health and shall follow Chapter 9.5, commencing with Section 118321, of the California Health and Safety Code, of the Medical Waste Management Act.
