- 1) **30**th and C St Market Conditional Use Permit (CUP), Project Number 646980 (Process 3). Conditional Use Permit (CUP) for the sale of alcoholic beverages located at 2985 C Street. The 0.24-acre site is located on the corner of 30th and C St. in the CN-1-3 zone. Discuss outcome of August 19th public hearing and the GGHPC's appeal of the hearing officer's decision.
- 2) Community Planning Group Elections under COVID-19 restrictions and GGHPC Open Board Positions. GGHPC has two current open positions but has been unable to hold elections for these positions due to the COVID-19 meeting restrictions and elections procedures in the GGHPC bylaws. Discuss potential ideas for holding on-line or email-based elections for these open seats.
- 3) **Nominations for Vice Chair of the GGHPC:** Call for nominations for the Vice Chair position. Current Vice Chair, Tim Briggs will be resigning at the end of the month due to moving outside of the Greater Golden Hill community.
- 4) New CPG Budget and Expense Policy from the Planning Department. The City Planning Department has provided an updated template for CPG reimbursement and CPG Budget Guidelines for FY 21. Review approved expenditures and modify, if needed and establish a reimbursement requester/recipient.
- 5) **State Route Hwy. 94 Park Lid:** Consider establishing an ad-hoc subcommittee to explore the potential for a park lid over the 94 to renew historic links between Golden Hill and Sherman Heights and provide additional park and recreation space for our communities. This project was previously associated with a CalTrans project for modifications to the 94 that were being discussed in 2016.
- 6) **Golf Course Drive Improvements (\$14006).** Provide an update on the status of this CIP project and consider forming an ad-hoc subcommittee to continue to track and report on the project schedule and funding.
