- 1) Convene. Anne Fege, Chair, called the meeting to order at 11:45 a.m.

- 3) Approval of Minutes. Minutes of the April 13 and May 11 meetings were approved.
- 4) Action Items. None.
  - a) Board discussed and approved letter to the Mayor and Council about the imperative of inspections and code compliance for trees in the City. Inspections and compliance checks are occurring rarely in the City. Most development permits incorporate trees in the landscaping design, and years later many of those trees are missing, dead, topped, or are otherwise unhealthy.
  - b) Board discussed and approved letter to the Mayor and Council about the need for arboriculture expertise in sidewalk and other public works projects, particularly early in the design phase and in the construction monitoring.
  - c) Board discussed and recommended nomination of Brazilian pepper tree at 6801 Mission Gorge Road, as a heritage tree. The tree is primarily as it is 50 years old but has no apparent historic connection. City staff have inspected the tree and have public safety concerns.

- a) Barrick gave a brief update on tree planting, tree inventory, and urban tree canopy assessment (CalFire grant).
- b) Arias reported that 14 Jacaranda trees will be planted at Roosevelt and Richmond streets, using Figg Funds.
