Park Permits

Our Recreation Centers and Parks are a great venue to hold meetings, birthday parties and special events. The Recreation Centers include amenities such as meeting rooms, kitchens, picnic shelters, multi-purpose fields and gymnasiums. All park users must obtain a Park Use Permit five (5) days in advance for any equipment in the park (e.g. jumpers, generators, canopies, etc.). Proof of insurance may be required to obtain a permit.

Appointment required to obtain a park permit.

Registration

Registration for all classes is on a first come, first served basis. We accept all major credit cards. You must register at the Recreation Center where your class is scheduled or on-line at www.SDRecConnect.com. Registration fees must be paid by the first class of the session/month.

Participants that have not paid by the second class will not be permitted to participate until fees are paid. To find your class use the Activity # listed in this program.

Fall Seasons: fees for 3 month classes are valid from September 1 to November 30. There is no prorating. Registration starts August 19th at 10:00 am. There is a \$25.00 service fee for all returned checks. A liability waiver, photo and birth certificate are required when registering for youth sports.

Refunds

Refunds are based on the date written application was submitted, using the Refund Application, in person at the facility where the program occurs. Refunds will be processed in accordance with the following policy.

Refund policy information:

- 3% processing fee will be deducted from all refunds.
- No refund or transfer for non-attendance at any activity.
- No credit to account.
- Activity fees less than \$10.00 will not be refunded.
- No refunds for costumes or equipment.
- Payments made by credit card will be refunded to the credit card.
- Refunds can take up to 6 weeks to process.
- For more details, see refund policy included in your registration receipt, which supersedes any information listed above.

Community Advisory Groups

The role of Community Recreation Groups (CRGs) are to make recommendations to City Council, the Department, and its various boards with respect to recreation programs in the community and to provide recommendations on the expenditure of Recreation Center Funds. The City does not delegate any authority to Community Recreation Groups to act on behalf of the City. Community Recreation Groups are voluntarily created and maintained by their members.

Payment Process

Payments accepted online at SDRecConnect.com or at your specific recreation center.

- Only a parent or legal guardian may register participants under the age of 18.
- Acceptable payment methods include: electronic check– proper ID with proof of checking account (blank or void– ed check) or credit, debit, or gift cards issued by qualified card service merchants (Visa, MasterCard, American Ex– press, and Discover only)
- A \$25.00 fee will be charged for declined electronic checks
- Customers should verify that bank routing and account numbers are entered correctly.
- Activities not meeting the minimum enrollment may be cancelled.
- All registration and reservation fees include a nonrefundable 3% processing fee.
