Yesterday the Council's Infrastructure Committee met for the second time and discussed a range of issues, including community input and asset management practices. Asset management is a hot topic in the wake of three major water main bursts last week. One of the pipes that ruptured was 102 years old—it was installed while William Howard Taft was President!

The Committee voted to create a citywide asset management policy that will work to prevent such lapses in the future, in our water system and all other asset groups. The Committee also voted to create a community input policy, to insure residents have a say in how the City prioritizes projects.

## Small Business Health Tax Credit

As the March 15 corporate tax filing deadline approaches, small businesses should be aware they can reduce their federal tax burden if they provide health insurance to their employees. The Small Business Healthcare Tax Credit, a provision of the Affordable Care Act (ACA), is available now and was designed to encourage both small businesses and tax-exempt employers to maintain existing coverage or offer health insurance to their employees for the first time. To be eligible for the credit, the business must have 25 or fewer employees, an average annual wage of less than \$50,000 and pay at least 50 percent of the employees' insurance premiums.
