SAN DIEGO, CA – Councilmember Chris Ward (District Three) issued the following statement after an update to San Diego’s Inclusionary Housing Policy was passed out of the Rules Committee.

"San Diegans are struggling under the weight of this housing crisis," said Councilmember Ward. "The longer we wait to address this crisis, the more time the ripple effects have to spread throughout our economy and hurt the thousands of working families struggling to make ends meet.

"Today's action was a substantial step in the right direction, updating a 16-year-old inclusionary policy will help produce affordable housing for our communities.
