

**CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:**  
**Miramar Reservoir Parking Lot Improvement Landscape Removal**

Jan. 24, 2023

As part of the parking lot improvements at Miramar Reservoir in preparation for construction of the City of San Diego Subaqueous Pipeline, the City's contractor conducted approved landscape removal as per the approved construction contract. A qualified biologist was present overseeing the landscape removal, which did not include any Torrey pines or sensitive habitat. It included landscaping that served as screening for the adjacent Miramar Drinking Water Plant. After the parking lot improvements are complete, landscaping will be restored to provide a similar level of screening.

The parking lot improvements were developed as part of the City's Pure Water Phase 1 Working Group process, an extensive community engagement process during the planning of the Pure Water Program, and these parking lot improvements will result in additional parking stalls for access and recreation at Miramar Reservoir.

**When:** Landscaping removal was completed on Friday, Jan. 13. Weather permitting, parking lot improvement work is scheduled to take approximately a month through mid-February 2023. Working hours will be from Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

**Why:** The Subaqueous Pipeline is a one-mile, branched pipeline at Miramar Reservoir that will include construction with pipeline assembly on barges on the surface of the reservoir before being sunk and permanently installed on the floor of the lakebed.

Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply.
