

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:
Parking Lot Improvement Work Continues for Miramar Reservoir

Feb. 6, 2023

Parking lot improvements are ongoing at Miramar Reservoir in preparation for construction of the City of San Diego Subaqueous Pipeline.

What To Expect: Curb and gutter work will occur in the large parking lot. This work includes demolition of the existing curb and gutter and installation of curb and gutter along the southern fenceline near the Miramar Drinking Water Plant.

Please plan extra time for parking when visiting Miramar Reservoir.

When: Weather permitting, curb and gutter work is scheduled on Wednesday, Feb. 8, and Thursday, Feb. 9. Working hours will be from Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply.

The Subaqueous Pipeline is a one-mile, branched pipeline at Miramar Reservoir that will include construction with pipeline assembly on barges on the surface of the reservoir before being sunk and permanently installed on the floor of the lakebed.
