

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE:
Parking Lot Improvement Work Scheduled for Miramar Reservoir

Jan. 5, 2023

Weather permitting, starting the second week of January 2023, parking lot improvements will occur at Miramar Reservoir in preparation for construction of the City of San Diego Subaqueous Pipeline.

What To Expect: Improvements will include installation of additional parking stalls.

Traffic control will be in place during this work with one-way traffic maintained by flaggers. Please plan extra time for parking when visiting Miramar Reservoir.

The Subaqueous Pipeline is a one-mile, branched pipeline at Miramar Reservoir that will include construction with pipeline assembly on barges on the surface of the reservoir before being sunk and permanently installed on the floor of the lakebed.

When: Weather permitting, parking lot improvements are scheduled to take approximately a month starting the second week of January. Working hours will be from Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will provide a reliable, sustainable water supply.
