

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE: Subaqueous Pipeline Construction Equipment Staging Planned at Miramar Reservoir

April 12, 2023

In preparation for construction of the City of San Diego Subaqueous Pipeline as part of Pure Water San Diego, the contractor will stage equipment and construction materials in the parking lot at Miramar Reservoir beginning on April 27, 2023.

What To Expect: Sections of parking spaces in the main parking lot at Miramar Reservoir will

be used for construction equipment and materials. To prepare for construction and offset the space needed for construction equipment, new

parking spaces were developed and configured for parking during

construction.

Please plan extra time for parking when visiting Miramar Reservoir. Please note that public access to the delineated construction staging area will be

prohibited for safety and security.

When: Construction staging, including equipment and materials storage, will begin

on April 27, 2023, and remain in place through construction. Construction on the Subaqueous Pipeline is anticipated to begin in summer 2023, and additional schedule information will be provided when it is available.

Why: Pure Water San Diego is the City of San Diego's phased, multi-year program

that will provide nearly half of San Diego's water supply locally by 2035. The Pure Water Program will use proven water purification technology to clean recycled water to produce safe, high-quality drinking water. The Program offers a cost-effective investment for San Diego's water needs and will

provide a reliable, sustainable water supply.

The Subaqueous Pipeline is a one-mile, branched pipeline at Miramar Reservoir that will include construction with pipeline assembly on barges on the surface of the reservoir before being sunk and permanently

installed on the floor of the lakebed.
