# **GUN VIOLENCE RESTRAINING ORDER IMPOUNDS**

## I. <u>PURPOSE</u>

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide information and direction on the newly implemented GVRO Related impound feature.

## II. SCOPE


This Training Bulletin applies to sworn and civilian personnel who use FileOnQ Online Property Room.

## III. BACKGROUND

In 2018, the San Diego Police Department and The City Attorney's Office created a unit to address the implementation of Gun Violence Restraining Orders pursuant to Penal Code 18100. Gun Violence Restraining Orders prohibit persons from controlling, owning, purchasing, possessing, or receiving any firearms or ammunition. During their duties, officers coming into contact with persons prohibited from possessing the above listed items, shall collect and impound the items for safekeeping.

#### IV. PROCEDURES

When impounding firearms and ammunition pursuant to a Gun Violence Restraining Order, officers will check the GVRO Related check box on the FileOnQ Online Property form. This will provide easily accessible statistical information for analysis.
