As an individual, or a club unit, here's an opportunity to help! Before the California State Legislature is a bill, providing a small pension for the physically disabled, who, if they are in dire need now, have no way to subsist. This Assembly Bill No. 716 SHOULD BECOME A LAW OF THIS STATE.

TELL HIM YOU'D APPRECIATE HIS ENDORSEMENT OF BILL #716, ASK HIM TO SEE THAT IT PASSES BOTH THE COMMITTEES AND THAT IT COMES BEFORE THIS SESSION, TO BE MADE A LAW OF THIS STATE.

Who can help? You, those city officials..the mayor, the council, etc. Then, your group..P.T.A., Lions, Kiwanis, the Women's clubs, Chamber of Commerce...Your church groups, ministers, civic leaders and all community groups. WRITE THAT LETTER TODAY. SEND YOUR CLUB'S ENDORSEMENT TO US. WE'LL SEE THAT IT IS PASSED ALONG TO THE LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEES PROMPTLY.

Clasp the hand of your friends and join us in helping this pension plan to aid the needy disabled. The blind receive \$60.00 per month...the disabled nothing. The bill provides for a minimum of \$35.00, and the person must have been a resident of this state for a period of 15 years to be eligible.
