

Open Space and Conservation Goals

- An open space system that preserves canyonlands, habitat, and sensitive biological resources.
- Healthy and resilient development patterns that preserve natural landforms, public and private open spaces, wildlife linkages, sensitive habitat, and natural drainage systems.
- Sustainable design that reduces emissions and dependency on non-renewable energy sources, makes efficient use of local resources, and incorporates sustainable storm-water management.
- A system of sensitively designed open space trails linking pedestrians and bicyclists to parks, schools and major activity centers through connected paths and bikeways.
- A sustainable and efficient land use pattern and mobility system that reduces greenhouse gas emissions and motorized vehicle trips.
